**Current Concepts in Oral & Maxillofacial
Pathology for the OMS Practitioner: From
Diagnosis to Reconstruction**

Presented by

Joshua Lubek DDS, MD, FACS

This course will focus on various pathologic diseases involving the oral and maxillofacial region encountered by the OMS practitioner. Topics of discussion will include pre-malignant disease, oral and oropharyngeal cancer, salivary gland disease, odontogenic cysts & tumors and novel therapeutics. Special topics including osteoradionecrosis, medication-induced osteonecrosis and dental rehabilitation of the maxillofacial tumor defect will also be covered.

Learning Objectives:

- 1) Discuss various oral dysplastic lesions including diagnosis and management and their risk of transformation to oral squamous cell cancer.
- 2) Understand the role of surgery, chemoradiotherapy and immunotherapy in the management of oral squamous cell cancer.
- 3) Discuss the role of the human papillomavirus in both oral cavity and oropharyngeal cancer.
- 4) Understand the application of robotic surgery in the management of oral and oropharyngeal tumor management.
- 5) Review the role of both non-surgical and surgical management in the treatment of osteoradionecrosis and medication-related osteoradionecrosis of the jaws.
- 6) Discuss current concepts in the diagnosis and management of both salivary gland pathology and odontogenic cysts & tumors of the oral cavity.
- 7) Review reconstructive options for the maxillofacial tumor patient including bone grafts pedicled flaps, microvascular surgery, and dental rehabilitation.
- 8) Discuss the role of the surgeon-prosthodontist interface in the rehabilitation of the maxillofacial tumor patient.
