**Obstructive Sleep Apnea:
A Comprehensive Review
and Management Strategies**

Common and often undiagnosed, obstructive sleep apnea can have a devastating effect on the health and quality of life of our patients. As oral health providers, we have the opportunity to identify concerning risks factors before dangerous sequelae develop. Our educational background and expertise also provides unique insight into the anatomy of the airway. A thorough understanding of the disease process and options available help us ensure timely management, therapeutic success, and long-term patient outcomes. This course is designed to emphasize and engage your role in the management obstructive sleep apnea.

Course Objectives:

- 1) Identify risk factors and screening methods for patients who may have obstructive sleep apnea.
- 2) Review the diagnosis and classification of obstructive sleep apnea with an emphasis on home diagnostic testing.
- 3) Discuss strategies for patient counseling and non-surgical options, focusing on oral appliance therapy.
- 4) Describe techniques for targeted airway analysis
- 5) Comprehensively compare established and novel surgical therapies.

The scientific program will include several experts to address a multi-faceted health problem in a multi-disciplinary fashion.

OBEAM—AAOMS National Simulation Program offers oral and maxillofacial surgeons the opportunity to practice critical techniques for administering and monitoring office-based anesthesia through best-practice protocols during simulation of various real-life emergency airway situations. AAOMS is providing the opportunity for OMS state and regional societies to offer the Office –Based Emergency Airway Management module. During the two-hour OBEAM module, participants review and practice concepts and skills for sedation monitoring and techniques for supplemental oxygen, opening and airway, bag-valve-mask (BVM) ventilation using one-and two-handed techniques, laryngeal mask airway (LMA) insertion and use of the Airtraq laryngoscope for endotracheal intubation (a procedure during which a tube is inserted into the windpipe). Ventilation parameters are manipulated so difficult BVM can be practiced and mastered after mastery of BVM in a normal configuration.

Registrants will receive 6 CE hours from AAOMS.
